### Tip of the month



Beakers showing the different pH colours & could be great for Open days.

- . 800ml beaker 600ml water + universal indicator -green
- 2. 600ml beaker with 2 drops of 1M HCl
- 3. 600ml beaker with 2 drops of 1M HCl
- 4. 400ml beaker with 2 drops of 1M HCl
- 5. 400ml beaker with 5drops of 1M NaOH6. 250ml beaker with 2 drops of 1M NaOH
- 7. 250ml beaker with 5ml buffer 7

## Pour;

- 500ml from beaker 1 into beaker 2 turns- pink-orange-lime
- 400ml from 2 into 3 orange-yellow
- 300ml from 3 into 4 pink-red
- 200ml from 4 into 5 purple-blue
- 100ml from 5 into 6 purple
- 50ml from 6 into 7 green
- You can then pour all of 7 into 6 into 5 into 4 into 3 into 2 into 1 neutralising all and turning all back to green as you go.

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
